Mini Youth Games - Athletics

We had a fabulous day at the Medway Mini Youth Athletics match where we competed against 65 schools from the Medway area. The day started with **Aylin** and **Jamie** both running the mini marathon which was 600m long with times of 2m 56.7s and 2m 38.6s respectively, gaining a 25th and 24th place. This was followed by the field events where Efe achieved an impressive standing vertical jump of 47cm, **Jamie** threw a cricket ball for 18.5m and both **Tanaka** and **Thea** impressed with speed bounces of 74 and 65 respectively.

Tanaka and Jesse then went on to throw well in the javelin event. This was followed by the triple and long jumps, which were an experience for the children as they actually got to run up on a track and jump into a proper sand pit. **Lulu** and **Freddie** had the task of triple jumping far enough from a pre-determined marker to land in the pit, which they succeeded at, where many other children failed. **Jesse** and **Jamie** then impressed us by landing on the take off board in exactly the correct position before jumping in the long jump pit. No mean feat!



The last two field events were the ball push where **Aylin** and **Efe** threw well, followed by the discus which both **Lulu** and **Freddie** managed to get out of the cage before scoring a distance of 7.6m and 12.05m respectively. The children were lucky



enough to be coached throughout the morning by the Kent Long Jump Champion, **Joanne Ware**. After some lunch, we then moved onto the races with **Thea** and **Freddie** competing in the 60m, **Efe** and **Jesse** competing in the 100m, **Tanaka** and **Lulu** competing in the 200m before all children competed in the relay races, where the children executed a perfect handover each time. **Efe** ran a very good 100m where he was pipped at the post into second place with a time of 14.9 seconds.

The overall result was that we were placed 28th out of 65, beating some very good quality schools in the area.
