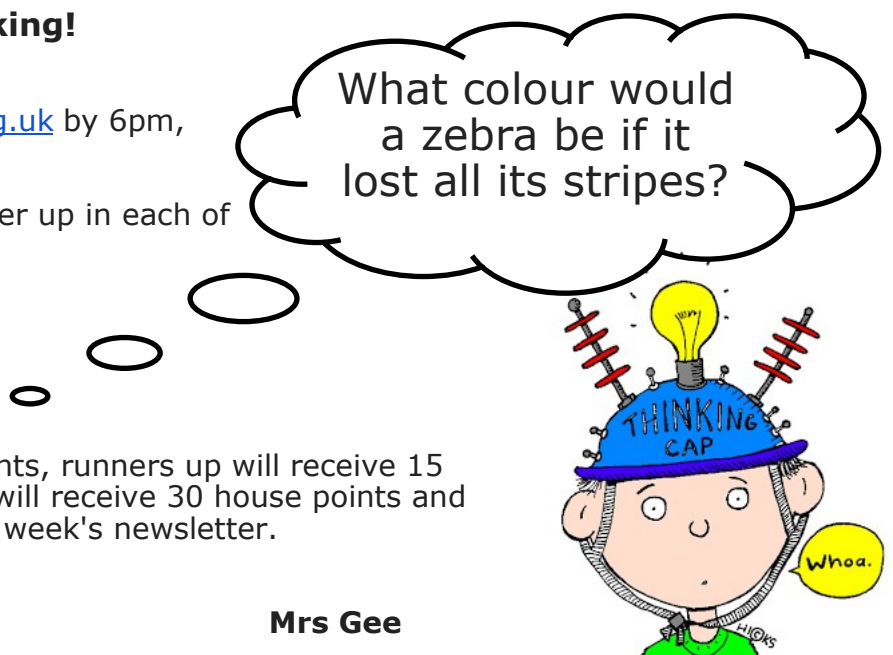
There will be a winner and a runner up in each of the following class groups:
