They were provided with information, advice and an insight into the important and vital role of the emergency services.

The children witnessed displays by the dog unit, horses, on public order and personal safety.

The dog units demonstrated their strong sense of smell, strength, communication and speed, whilst the public order display gave us an insight into the different forms of arrest and how the most extremely violent offenders are tackled.

The event was extremely well organised and the children loved getting a glimpse into the experience of an arrested person as they had their finger prints taken and went into a custody cell!

The experience opened our eyes into the many different aspects of the Police force and the hard work they do.

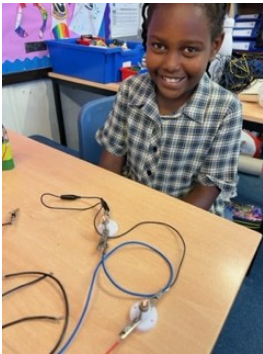
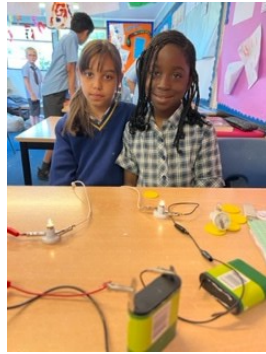

Last weekend some of our students performed on stage at the Woodville Halls Theatre Gravesend.



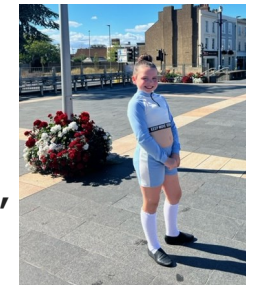
The children attend Razzamataz Theatre School Medway and the show celebrated the first 12 years of the school.

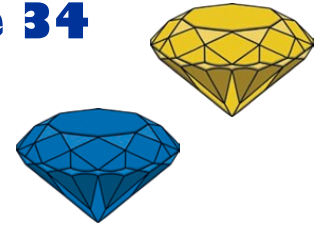
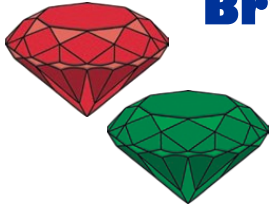
They have maintained the raspberry canes in the garden and last week picked many raspberries which they were able to take home.
