The children have been completing


photo portraits of soldiers. They look fantastic so far. I'm looking forward to displaying the end results! **Mrs Rivers**

Urging safe and responsible parking!

Although the majority of parents park with the safety of pupils in mind there are still a few cars at drop off and pick up times in dangerous positions despite parking restrictions being in place. A particular concern raised is those cars parked on the double yellow lines on a very busy junction where children are also crossing and cars turning who cannot see over the illegally-parked cars (see photo below - please keep both sides of this road clear).
