Frames Wanted

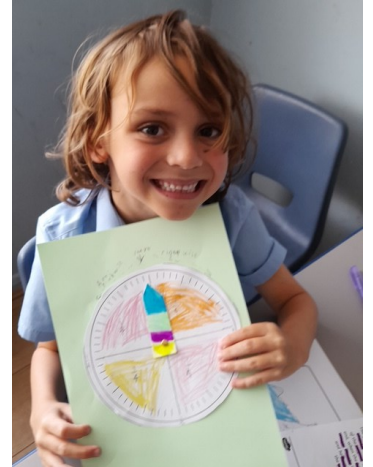

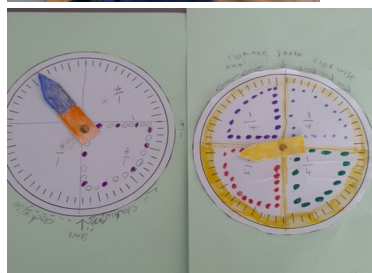


To help them with this tricky new concept they made these amazing position cards with cardboard, a template and spit pins.

Afterwards they all had fun using the arrow to try different kinds of turns.

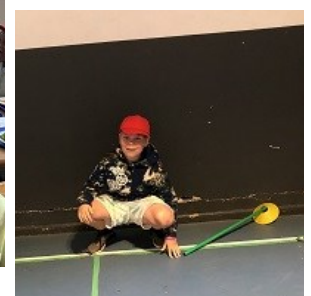
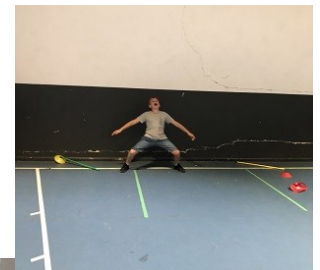
