## **Creative Computing**

On Monday 22nd May and Monday 5th June, the Year 5 classes went to the Infant school to partake in their computing

sessions. The majority of the morning was filled with work on a coding programme called Scratch. The children learnt how to use the tools available to make a wide range of mazes as backdrops. Some children used their free hand to create mazes.



whilst others used given shapes or straight lines. As the children created the mazes, they decided upon a theme for their game with a starting and end point, as well as a sprite/character to work around the maze that was appropriate to the theme, for example, a princess trying to get from the mountains to her castle or a skeleton/ghost trying to get the graveyard!



After this, the children worked hard to create algorithms for their sprites/characters to follow which would enable a player to move the sprite/character around the maze and if the sides were touched, the sprite would return back to the start! Some children even reached extension

activities like adding in an additional player to make it a 2 player race game, adding in boosts or even adding in extra levels. The

designs of the mazes were brilliant and I really enjoyed playing the games with the children as well as allowing them to share their games with each other!

In the afternoon, we reviewed our knowledge

on Google Slides. The children researched a

topic of their choice to form into a Slides presentation. The children learnt how to create backgrounds to their slides as well as use given 'themes' on the slides. They improved their typing skills by inputting information and then enhanced this further by adding in animation and



effective transitions. All the children displayed fantastic focus and enthusiasm for the subject and I also saw amazing peer support! There are certainly some budding computing geniuses in this year group! Well done to all!
