The children learnt how to take fingerprints, make moulds of footprints, detect forged signatures and carefully scrutinize evidence under a microscope.



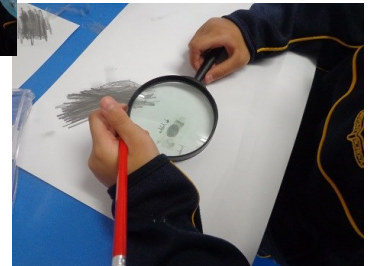
*(Continued from below)* They then had to step into the shoes of a real forensic crime investigator and interpret different evidence to find out who was the murderer.

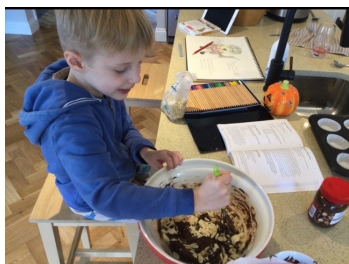

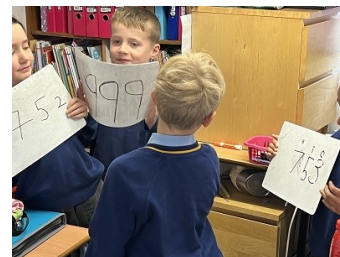
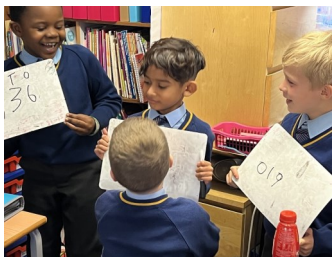
## Year 3 Cooking

Year 3 have been learning about recipes and made some lovely things in the half term. Well done year 3!



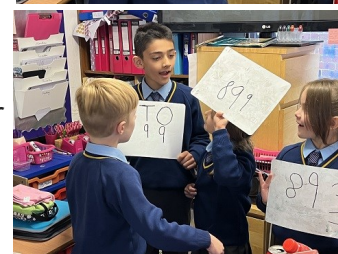

## Number Ordering

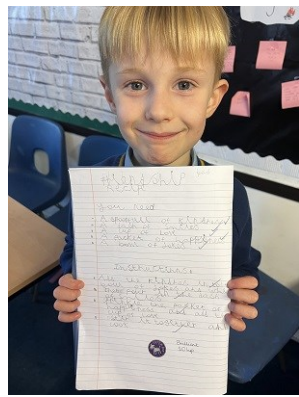
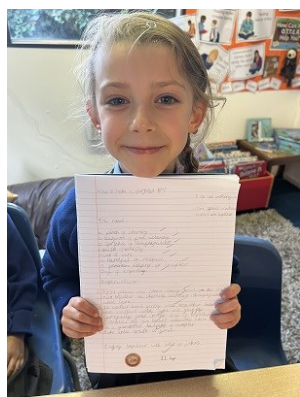


Year 3 have been learning about ordering numbers. We made our own number line.

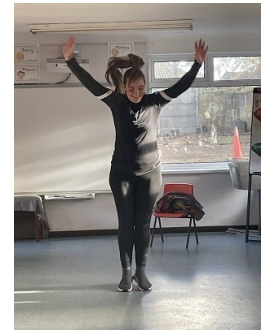
## Children In Need

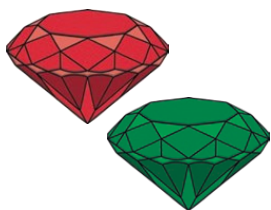

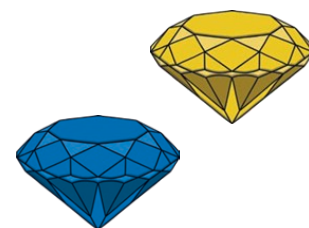
