Rangoli Patterns




Year 2 enjoyed our Art lesson outside last week. After learning about **Diwal**i in Religious Education, the children worked in groups to create Rangoli patterns.







The children learnt how to take finger prints, make moulds of footprints, detect forged signatures and carefully scrutinize evidence under a microscope.

Year 3 have been learning about ordering numbers. We made our own number line.






Children In Need


