On 28th November, the children of year 6 visited the Museum of Kent Life to experience life as a child during World War II (WW II), and especially as a child evacuee moving from the city to the countryside. This was an exciting and interactive day out which helped bring our learning on WW II on our topic lessons to life.

The children (and their teachers) had the opportunity to dress as a child

during the war, to fully

empathise with an evacuee. During the day the children engaged in various workshops such as a drill with the staff sergeant in the Home Guard, Dig for Victory, writing a letter home as an evacuee and also making a rug out of rags. It made the children aware of how tough life was for everyone during the war years. Thank you Miss Jug, Mr Johnson and Mr Wood for taking the children.


