

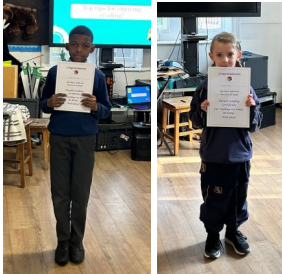

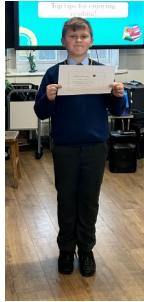

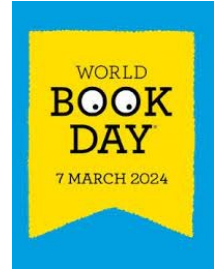
This week in R.E. the year 6's learnt about Saint David's Day and Wales.

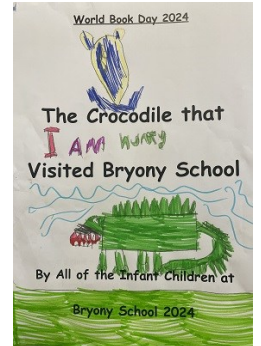
World Book Day
