
We all had lots of fun singing with the other schools and enjoyed seeing our families in the audience.

As part of the circulatory system, Year 6 children have been looking at how other systems in the body link together including how our lungs transfer oxygen to our blood to














For their homework, Year 6 were asked to create a model of the lungs: haven't they done a good job? These look fantastic!




